Unitech Plasto Components is committed to optimize its energy footprint to support a sustainable world.

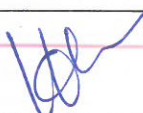
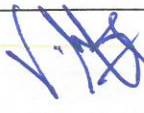
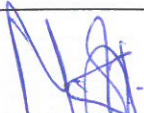
